


'REaction updates'

Faces of Easter

This March we are holding 2 REaction days in Beverley Minster and 1 in Bridlington.

The theme of the days will be 'The Faces of Easter' and will explore how different people respond to Jesus' life, death and resurrection.



Advent

In November we held our Advent REaction event at Beverley Minster, looking at the Christmas story and what the coming of Jesus means for Christians around the world.

There were workshops looking at Advent music and songs, the festivals of Christingle and Hanukkah, the coming of Jesus and real-life rescue through drama and music and games. The drama workshop explored Lights of Hope, where the children acted out a real-life story of being trapped in darkness, waiting a long time for light to come and rescue them. This was the story of the Thai boys football team who were trapped in a cave. They then thought about how the rescue



of the boys is like how Christians feel about Jesus. He has rescued us from darkness and brought us into the light and to life.

Isaiah 9:2 - The people walking in darkness have seen a great light; on those living in the land of the shadow of death, a light has dawned.

Mentoring

As part of my role at South Hunsley Secondary School, in partnership with Hunsley Christian Youth Trust, I mentor students. Meaning I meet with them weekly for about 30 minutes. They vary in age, come from a range of home backgrounds and face different challenges.

Many young people in today's culture don't have a trusted adult they can talk to or turn to in times of need. Many find it hard to talk about their feelings, or even understand them. They are often confused, anxious and lonely.

When they first come to see me they can be rather defensive and closed off, not wanting to appear vulnerable or weak, but after a while their demeanour changes. They relax and feel safe, knowing I will listen without judgement, support them without condemnation and journey alongside them without fearing I will abandon them.

It's a privilege to watch as they unravel, take down the walls and share their feelings, often for the first time. Then to watch them grow in self confidence and resilience.

One young person said 'thank you for listening to me, I feel I've been able to say things that have been hidden away. Sharing them has helped me feel strong.'

As I reflect on my work supporting students, I'm thankful for the support I have through family and friends who listen and guide. Ultimately I'm thankful for my faith in Jesus, Who through life's storms has always been my rock and strength.

My faith often comes up in conversation with the students I see. I'm able to share from personal experience the peace I have felt in knowing Jesus and His love for me.

I hope the work supporting students continues and that they would come to know that they are loved, handmade and have a hope for the future.


Introducing Cathy, the newest member of the team!
